The Austrian CLO has 3 levels, 3 dimensions:

1. Clerkship admission

Anamnesis: 5 items

Physical: 25 items

Basic skills: 13 items

2. Final year admission

3. Graduation

blueprint for 10-min stations



Course in year 2	Physical exam	History taking	Basic skills
Physical examination	(any parts of) physical exam		
History taking		specific anamnesis (headache, fever, abdomial pain)	
Scrub up: hygiene for ward and OT			surcigal hand disinfection OR dress for isolation room
Venipuncture			taking venous blood OR administer an i.v. infusion
Surgical skills			wound-dressing single knot tie OR remove sutures



results 2013



Cut-off	% score
Cut-on	70 SCOLE
Physical	73,02
History	72,51
Scrub up	66,74
Venipuncture	67,06
Surgical skills	70,51

• Failure rate:

42/272 (15 %) once

2/42 twice

acceptance and feedback



students:

- very few withdrawals
- contents meaningful
- format well accepted

teachers:

- E-checklists helpful
- clinician-raters scarce
- students prepared sufficiently
 well (either at first or second attempt)

Prospects for OSCEs:



- Second MUI OSCE piloted in 2013:
 - "Basic surgery skills" course in year 4
 - 5 stations
 - Pass rate >95%, well accepted by students

New MUI Dean declares to "go for more OSCEs"

Prospects for OSCEs:



More discipline-specific OSCEs?

- Level-2 OSCE ? (before final year)
- Level-3 OSCE ? (graduation)

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main obstacles:

- need for change in traditional practicals?
- proper room ensemble
- clinicians´ time
- money (SP, rater time)
